THE GENESIS OF THE SCHOOL

A Journey of Faith and Commitment

In 1970, Italian volunteers working with AVSI in Kitgum District identified a significant need for early childhood education for their children, as nursery schools were virtually unknown in the region at the time. To address this, they invited a kindergarten teacher, Mrs. Hellen Paganini, who began teaching the children of AVSI staff at the Priests' Residence, now the staff quarters.

As word spread, local staff members also started enrolling their children, leading to increased demand and the need for a larger space. Recognizing the growing interest in structured early education, Mrs. Paganini transformed the care center into a formal nursery school. She partnered with Fr. Tiboni, the Rector of Christ the King Seminary, who sought assistance from Giulio Andreotti, then Prime Minister of Italy. With his support, funds were secured to build the school's first classrooms and water facilities.

The school was named Giulio Pastore, in honor of Giulio Andreotti's longtime family friend.

Official Inauguration and Growth

In 1974, the school was officially launched as a faith-based institution under the Catholic Church of Gulu Archdiocese at Christ the King Parish, Kitgum. Initially managed by Italian volunteers in collaboration with the Parish Priest and laity, the school transitioned to local administration in 1987. In 1990, the school expanded to primary education under the leadership of Mr. Phillip Odwong as the headteacher who registered the school with the Ministry of Education and Sports in 2000 with the registration number PPS/G/26.

Leadership and Milestones

In 1976, the school's first Board of Governors was inaugurated by His Lordship Cyprian Dr. Kihangire, then Bishop of Gulu Diocese. Over the years, successive boards have guided the school's development. In 1999, due to changes in government policy, the payment of teachers by government stopped which

led to a temporary closure in 2006 due to staff management challenges. Christ the King parish under the leadership of Fr. Anthony Nyeko, the school was re-established in 2013 and has since grown steadily.

Achievements Today

As we celebrate 50 years of service, Giulio Pastore Nursery and Primary School stands as a beacon of resilience and success:

- **Enrollment Growth:** From 424 pupils in 2022 to 778 in 2024.
- **Staff Excellence:** 31 dedicated and qualified staff members.
- **Infrastructure:** 100% access to sustainable solar-powered clean water and a 90% safe school environment.
- **Parent Engagement:** Parental commitment has risen from under 50% to 85%.
- **Financial Stability:** Zero debt, with the school rated over 75% fit for providing quality education by the Ministry of Education and Sports.

Giulio Pastore Nursery and Primary School continues to honor its Catholic foundation, serving as a model of educational excellence and community commitment. As we celebrate this golden jubilee, we express our gratitude to all who have contributed to this remarkable journey.

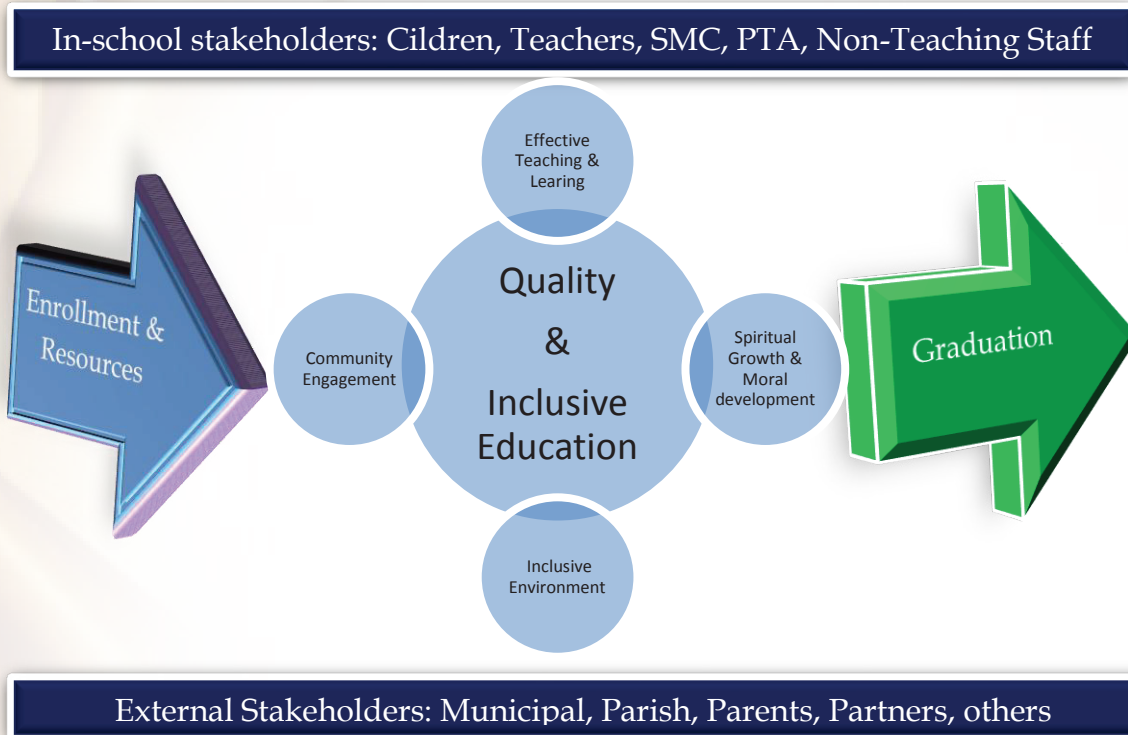
School Vision

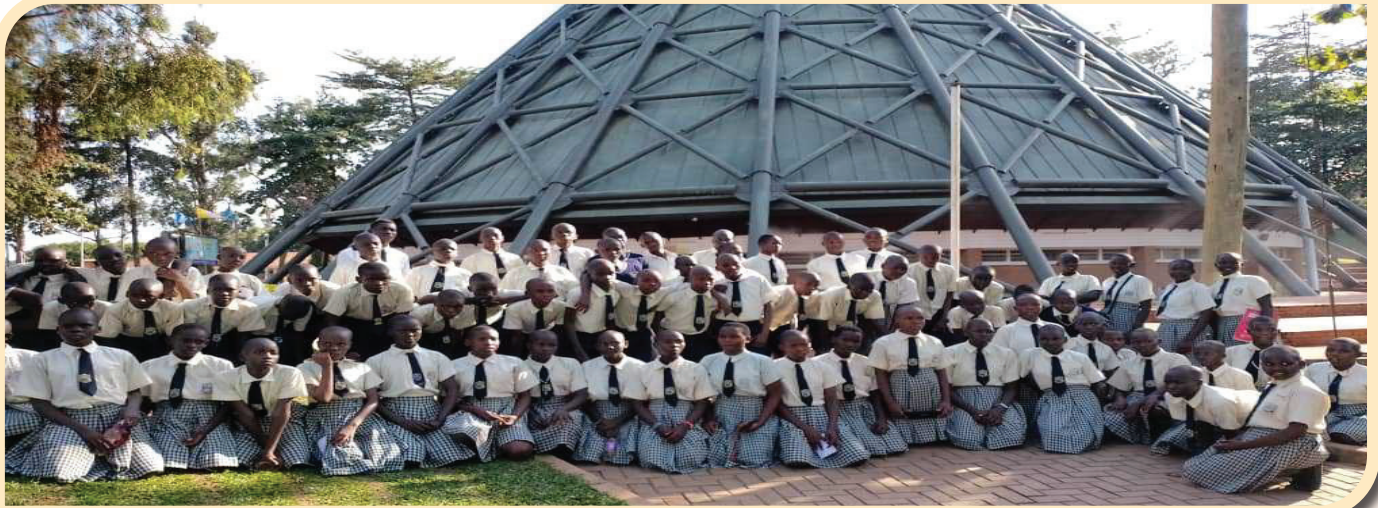

FORMER SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

The school was run by the Italian volunteers in conjunction with the Parish Priest and some laity. In 1976, the first Board of Governors of Giulio Pastore pre-primary School until 1986. In 1987, the school operation was taken over by the native teachers later the school expanded to provide primary education in 1990.

From the conception of the school to date,

the school was managed by difference group of management committee which by then was referred to as Board of Governor unlike today we call them School Management Committee (SMC). So the first Board members to run the school was inaugurated by His Lordship Cyprian Dr. Kihangire who was the Bishop of Gulu Diocese in 1976 –1977 and the sequence continued up to the current SMC.

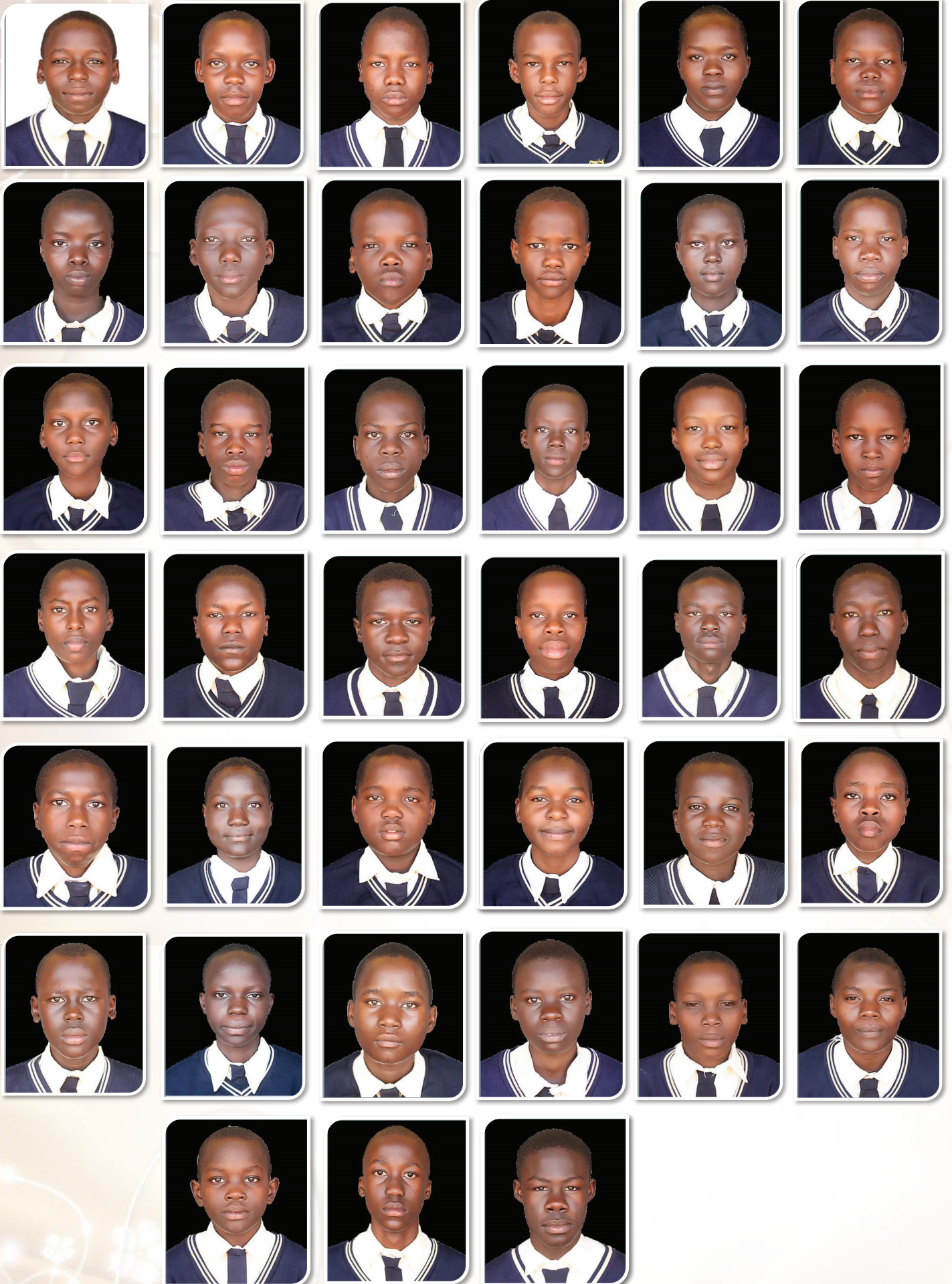
